• Carpool

- Morning Drop-off All students should be dropped off in the Lower School carpool loop. Drop off is from 7:30am to 7:50am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Homeroom begins at 7:50am. Students arriving after 7:50am are considered tardy and must sign in with the receptionist in the Lower School office. For the safety of students, we ask that students not be dropped off prior to 7:30am.
 - We encourage all students to arrive on campus between 7:30 and 7:45am to allow enough time to unpack and prepare for their day.
 - Please note, times are one hour later on Wednesday mornings due to our **late-in Wednesday schedule.** Please contact us if this late start on Wednesdays poses an undue burden for your family.
- Afternoon Pick-up Lower School carpool begins at 2:55pm. Lower School students who have not been picked up by 3:10pm will be taken to Extended Day.
 - If you have a student in the Middle School, you can pick up both your Lower School child(ren) and Middle School child(ren) in the Lower School carpool loop between 3:15 and 3:30.
 - If you are picking up your Middle and Lower School children together, please do not arrive in the Lower School loop until 3:15pm.
 - All after school pick up information for Lower School students must be entered into School Dismissal Manager (information will be shared on how to use this app prior to the start of school)
