2. During the first week of your AP class in the fall (date TBA), you will be expected to give an oral presentation to highlight the most important activities that you did in the summer. You need to have appropriate visual support to go along with your presentation. You can either make a poster or a PowerPoint slide show. During the oral presentation, you will be permitted to have a small note card for you to write down some bullet points; however, you will not be allowed to read from the card.

You will be graded based on the Intermediate Presentational Speaking Rubric, and it will be considered as a major assessment.

Reading

Read 3 cultural folk tales of your choice. The copies of books will be given before summer. Your goal is to be able to retell the story in your own words.

Writing

A. Search one of two Chinese classical novels, *Journey to the West* (西游记) or *Dream of the Red Chamber* (红楼梦). You need to write a book report for one of these two novels, and the following information needs to be addressed in your book report (minimum 100 words).

1. Name of the author
2. Date the book was written
3. Main characters
4. What is this book about?
5. Reviews and criticism of this book.

B. Choose one Chinese speaking movie to watch (with or without English subtitles) and type a summary and reflections (minimum 100 words). The list is as followed:
