

BACK TO SCHOOL BASICS LOWER SCHOOL 2019-2020

• Homeroom Assignments

• All students should receive a letter from their homeroom teacher between August 7th and 9th.

• School Supplies

- The school will provide necessary supplies to all students in the Lower School.
- The school will supply iPads to all students in grades 1-4.

• New Family Orientation

- Wednesday, August 14th 5:30-6:15pm
 - We encourage all new parents and new students to attend this event. Please park in the Lower School parking lot when you arrive.
 - New students will meet grade level/homeroom teachers and explore classrooms while parents attend an informative session on Lower School logistics (i.e. carpool, daily schedule, attendance expectations)

• The First Days of School for First Graders - Half Days (dismissal at 11:30)

- Tuesday, August 20th through Friday, August, 23rd
 - These will be half-days for first graders. First grade students will be dismissed from the Lower School carpool loop at 11:30am (no lunch will be served to first graders; there will be no Upper School carpool, bus service or Extended Day for first grade). All first grade students must be picked up from the Lower School carpool loop at 11:30.
 - All students are expected to wear their regular school uniform (no PE uniforms).
 - Please park in the Lower School parking lot (or other designated areas; not in LS carpool loop or on Albemarle Road) and walk your child in to meet his/her teacher between 7:30am and 8:15am (we will begin class at 8:15am).
 - Parents will receive important papers from the classroom teacher between 7:30am and 8:15am including the "official" name sign that is necessary for afternoon carpool.
- Regular full days for first graders will begin on Monday, August 26th.

• First Day of School Schedule for Second through Fourth Graders - Full Day

- Tuesday, August 20th The first day of school
 - It will be a full day of school for grades two through four with dismissal at 2:55pm from the Lower School carpool loop. There will be Upper School carpool, bus service, and Extended Day for grades two through four.
 - Please park in the Lower School parking lot (or other designated areas; not in LS carpool loop or on Albemarle Road) and walk your child in to meet his/her teacher between 7:30am and 8:15am (we will begin class at 8:15am).
 - All students are expected to wear their regular school uniform (no PE uniforms)
 - Parents will receive important papers from the classroom teacher between 7:30am and 8:15am including the "official" name sign that is necessary for afternoon carpool.

• Lower School Parents Night is Wednesday, August 28th, 6:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

• The program will begin in Gwynette Auditorium prior to classroom visits.

• Lunch

- While parents are welcome to join their children for lunch throughout the school year, we request that parents do not come for lunch until the week of September 9th. This allows our children time to acclimate to lunchroom procedures and expectations.
 - Please note: When coming to campus for lunch, all parents need to check in at the Lower School office and pay the \$5.00 fee.

• Carpool

- Morning Drop-off All students should be dropped off in the Lower School carpool loop. Drop off is from 7:30am to 7:50am. Homeroom begins at 7:50am. Students arriving after 7:50am are considered tardy and must sign in with the receptionist in the Lower School office. For the safety of students, we ask that students not be dropped off prior to 7:30am.
 - We encourage all students to arrive on campus between 7:30 and 7:45am to allow enough time to unpack and prepare for their day.
- **Afternoon Pick-up** Lower School carpool begins at 2:55pm. Students who have not been picked up by 3:10pm will be taken to Extended Day.

Visiting Campus

- For safety purposes our school gates remain locked at all times.
- When visiting campus, please enter through the gate by the Lower School office. You will need to checkin with the Receptionist and provide your driver's license.

• Chapel

- Chapel will be held every Wednesday beginning on August 28th from 12:00pm-12:25pm.
 - We invite parents to attend our weekly Chapel services.
