
# **WINTERIM** 2022-2023



# Cape Eluthera Institute, Bahamas | The Island School

The Island School offers an educational experience in an amazing setting. With the campus and surrounding ocean as laboratories, The Island School partners with a world-class science research facility. Together, they engage in the process of inquiry in order to discover sustainable solutions to real world problems. Students will explore the framework of Eleuthera's cultural and environmental landscape through student-centered academics, outdoor programs that support personal growth and leadership development, and outreach programs. The Island School experience culminates the beginning of a lifelong journey, with more self-confident students leaving as engaged global citizens, empowered to be active leaders of their generation.

Transportation, food and lodging, taxes, and tariffs are included in this trip.

This trip will be open to 7th and 8th grades only. The current dates of this trip are January 3-7.

**Approximate Cost: \$2,200-\$2,400** 

Maximum Students: 18 (9 boys & 9 girls)





# **Out of Town Programs**

# Jackson Hole, Wyoming An Expedition Into the Wild

This will be our fourth WINTERim adventure to Jackson and the Grand Teton National Park as we partner with our friends from the Teton Science School (TSS) and SKI 93 to provide students with a truly memorable experience. Students will explore the Greater Yellowstone ecosystem and geo-thermal conditions of Old Faithful with guides from the TSS in custom winter safari vehicles. Students from beginners to experts will spend days of remarkable skiing or snowboarding with instructors and guides from the Jackson Hole Mountain Resort. Cost includes airfare, meals, hotel lodging, TSS programs, lift tickets, lessons, and equipment rentals.

**This trip will be open to 6th - 8th graders.** The dates for this trip are yet to be determined.

**Approximate Cost: \$2,600-\$2,900**
